Orientation Reminder:

GCS will host a middle school orientation and a high school orientation on Thursday, August 30, 2018. The middle school orientation will begin at 5:00 PM in the chapel. SAT Preparation Course (Elective Course)

The GCS SAT course is a comprehensive course that provides thorough preparation for all areas of the New SAT exam. It covers content reviews to promote content mastery and teaches students the most dynamic and updated strategy and methods available. Students will work through the SAT Prep Plus 2019 workbook by Kaplan with access to more than 1,400 questions.

Virtual Apologetics (Technology Elective)

Students will experience the dynamics and flexibility of a technical virtual course. The objective of the class will be to teach students how to be part of a global learning community while developing essential life skills of time management and self-discipline. Students will complete this course with a classroom teacher, Mrs. Hogue, and a virtual professor, Mrs. Jamara, providing them with a college-like virtual course experience. The core content of the course will be apologetics--A branch of theology that deals with the defense and establishment of the Christian faith (1 Peter 3:15). The curriculums used in this course are titled Please Convince Me: Real Answers, For a Real Faith, In a Real World, written by Jim Wallace and The Gospels Museum of the Bible published by Positive Action for Christ. This technology course is a required state course for all high school students.
