Dual Enrollment Precalculus or Introductory Statistics:

Scheduling requires that the Dual Enrollment Precalculus and Introductory Statistics classes begin promptly at 7:50 AM. Precalculus and Statistics students need to arrive to school each morning their class is offered by 7:40 AM to go to their locker and get class materials. You will not be charged a Morning Care fee. Please note: If your student arrives to class after 7:50 AM, he/she will be counted tardy and this will negatively affect their grade. As a reminder, all dual enrollment courses are weighted on a 5 grade point scale. A student must earn a C in the dual enrollment course in order for it to transfer as a high school or college credit.
