### 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Bible Class: Winning the Race by Positive Action for Christ

Students will discover how various Bible characters strove to win the race that God set for them. This study also presents an overview of New Testament doctrine, including eschatology from the Book of Revelation.

### Fine Arts Elective Rotation Classes

The Technology elective was developed to teach students basic computer applications that will be used throughout their middle and high school careers. Students work to become proficient at Microsoft Office (Word, PowerPoint and Excel) as well as improve their word processing skills and speed. Sixth graders will take the Technology elective during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter and seventh graders during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter.

STEAM stands for science, technology, engineering, art, and mathematics. In this elective, students are introduced to the basic concepts within these disciplines. This elective expands students' minds and their imaginations using engaging hands-on lessons to solve real world problems. One goal of STEAM is to help students see the talents that God has given them and careers they can pursue to use those talents for His will. Seventh graders will take the STEAM elective during the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter and sixth graders during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter.

In the Spanish Cultures elective, students are exposed to the Spanish language and the beauty of another people group that God created. This elective class explores the rich culture, geography, people, customs and language of the many Spanish speaking countries throughout the world. This elective course provides a foundational introduction to the Spanish language courses required for graduation. Sixth graders will take the Spanish Cultures elective during the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter and seventh graders during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter.

The Middle School Art elective is fueled by the flexibility to create challenging and successful projects designed for various degrees of talent and artistic ability. Because art is a universal language, stories can be told, history can be taught, and creativity can soar through the expression of art. Seventh graders will take the Art elective during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter and sixth graders during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter.
